THE WICKED WILL PERISH

Dictionary def. of ‘perish’ – “1. To die or be destroyed, esp. in a violent manner. 2. To pass from existence;...” – American Heritage College ed.

Hebrew: “abad” – perish, destroy, demolish, annihilate;...

Greek: “apollymi” – to destroy (an inanimate object), to kill (by taking a life), cause to lose (especially a life); to die or perish...

THE WICKED ARE CONSUMED WITH NOTHING LEFT ALIVE

Dictionary Def. of “consume” – To destroy totally: *flames that consumed the house.*

“devour” – To destroy, consume, or waste: *flames devoured the house.*
